No	Topic	Highlights
1	Meeting attendance	⇒ Thanked attendees for their commitment, encouraged them to bring fellow class officers.
2	Spirit Week	⇒ Students expressed concern about field day and spirit week being combined. 11 th and 12 th grade representatives stated that during field day they are very busy selling and are not able to participate in many other activities, while during spirit week they are able to compete in sports against each other and teachers.
3	Field Day 2010	⇒ Students remembered difficulties with field day location from previous year and expressed dissatisfaction about having activity at same venue this year. ⇒ Students explored possibility, benefits and disadvantages of charging a small admissions fee for Field Day. ⇒ Counselor informed students that this was attempted but not approved in the past year to donate funds to Pituca Flores. ⇒ Students shared desired activities. ⇒ Counselor shared information about RECREATE game rentals with students. Students reviewed brochure.
4	Student empowerment	⇒ 8 th graders explained situation where according to them, teacher ended up selecting t-shirt color for them and majority in class are not happy because another grade ended up with their desired color. ⇒ 11 th and 12 th graders suggested that they don't worry as much because it is very likely that they will change colors again prior to graduation. ⇒ President spoke to students about teacher involvement in student council activities and decisions.

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5	Vision and Mission	⇒ Counselor provided activity sheet to help brainstorm ideas for the student council mission and vision statement. Students worked in pairs and later shared ideas.
