No	Topic	Highlights
1	Value of the Month	⇒ Students had previously selected to work on value of March corresponding to LOVE. Students agreed to take steps to promote the value in the school. Students will discuss possible ideas to implement with their class.
2	Field Day	⇒ Treasurer inquired about field day location and requested activities, identifying the following as their preferences. 1 st choice: Face painting 2 nd choice: Water slide & Obstacle course 3 rd choice: to be discussed with class Students expressed concern over availability of water at field day site.
3	Safety Issues	⇒ Students report that school director visited 8A and spoke to them about safety. Laura Jimenez was selected to be the safety monitor in the class. However 8B and C have not been visited and monitor has not been selected. Secretary suggested a monitor for one of the classes who takes safety seriously.
4	Other issues of concern	⇒ President reports general dissatisfaction in class about t-shirt color, which students say was selected by one of the teachers and not by students. ⇒ Vice-president stated that class has not been on field trip planned by science teacher because of reported difficulties in coordinating schedule with one of the homeroom teachers.
