1	Attendance & past meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Attendance taken and past meeting minutes read. ⇒ Students confirmed that they saw meeting sign and/or received meeting reminder in via mail/in person
2	Cheerleading Squad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Students described difficulties encountered (inquired about approval).
3	Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Toy Drive: Students will bring suggestions by Friday of entity to receive donation. General consensus to use “Live to Give” Motto or other suggested. We need to consider storage and safety of toys donated. ⇒ Beach Clean Up: Students expressed interest in beach clean up. Executive members will seek approval.

More support needed. ⇒ Student of the Month: Advisor reminded students to request nominations from homeroom teachers for selections. Most students report that process involving students is not being followed by teachers.
