Key Points Discussed		
No	Topic	Highlights
1	School Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Students discussed concern over certain safety issues that have been discussed in the past. Student reported that lockers have not been drilled to the walls as promised after Haiti's earthquake. Students described that they saw holes drilled into cabinets and cables inserted, but cabinets are not attached to wall. ⇒ Students commented that they would like to see fire, earthquake and tsunami drills practiced. Students described that they saw and practiced drill in health class when the topic was covered but added that more practice is necessary in groups and at a school wide level. ⇒ Student stated that rolling bookbags used by some middle school students make it difficult to walk when hallway is crowded and that they make circulation more difficult. One student commented that she has almost tripped over rolling bags. Another suggested that rolling bookbags not be allowed in middle school or otherwise not mix middle school and high school classes in same hallway.
2	Discipline Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Students discussed need for more consistency with rules and discipline for drills and in general. Student stated that Ms De Los Santos and Mrs. Bello are usually the teachers that watch out for correct uniform but otherwise feel that discipline needs to improve in the school. Students commented that they felt discipline was stronger when there was a specific teacher in charge of the area, such as Ms. Amantina and Mr.Perez.
3	Recycling Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Students inquired about bottle recycling plan which was discussed at previous meeting. Advisor reported that along with Ms. Nuñez she met with maintenance supervisor on April 8 who promised to paint a trash can with an alternative color and identify it as the plastic bottle bin for recycling.
